LAKENHEATH

ST MARY THE VIRGIN

Stunning wall paintings dating from the 13th to the 17th centuries. One of the finest survivals in England

KENTFORD - ST MARY'S

St Christopher and the three living and three dead.

CAVENHAM - ST ANDREW

A rare depiction of St Walstan with angels.

RISBY - ST GILES

Several painted schemes dating back to the 13th century including the Miracles of the Virgin.

GT LIVERMERE - ST PETER

Two unidentified figures and a consecration cross.

TROSTON - ST MARY

Large and spectacular St George and Martyrdom of St Edmund.

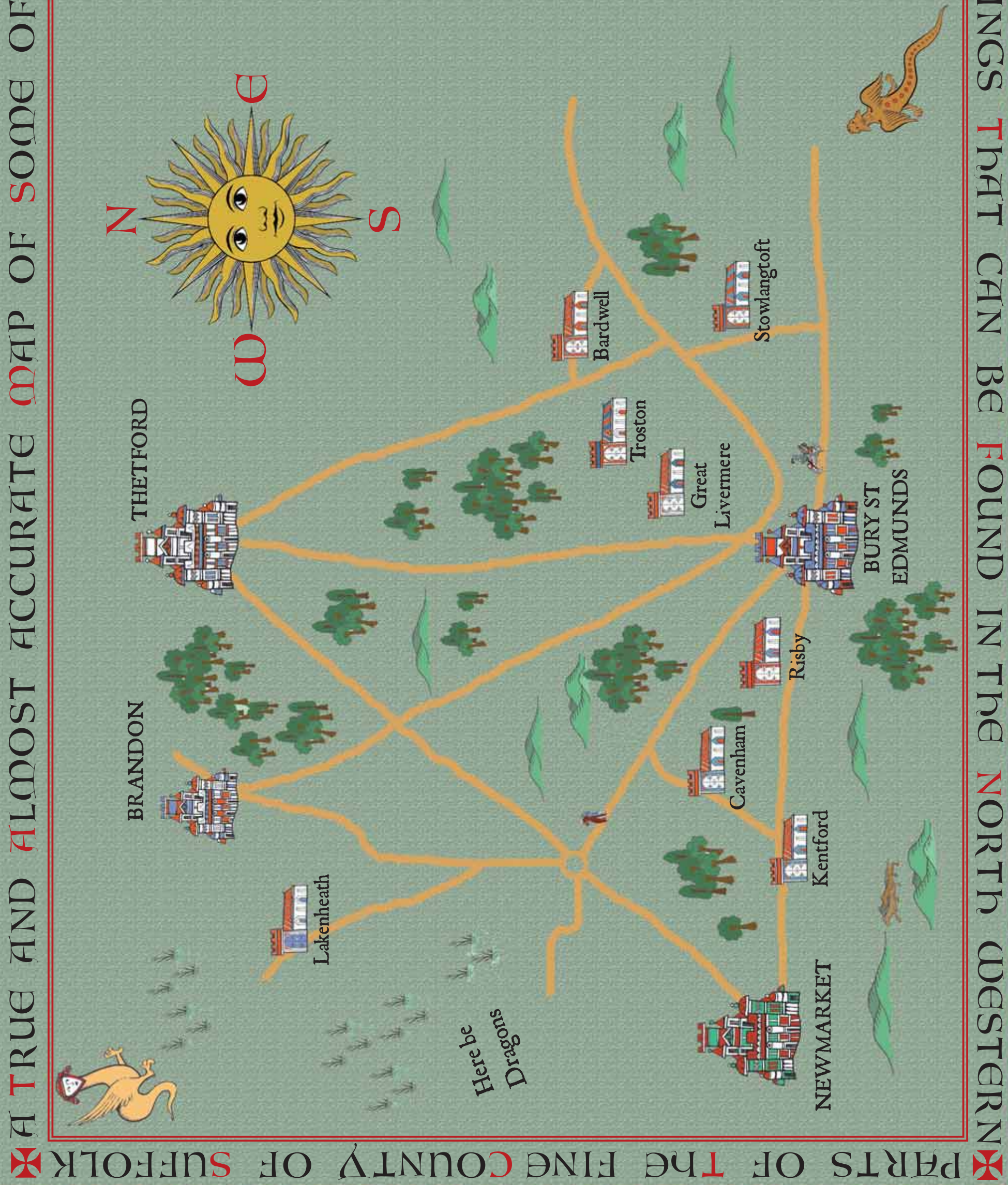
BARDWELL - Ss PETER & PAUL
